After many, many months of planning, meetings, more planning and even more meetings, work has begun on the re-development of James Terry Court.

The contractor selected to carry out the work is Mansell plc. Mansell are a long established construction company who are based in Croydon. Their team began work in March and the project will be completed in several stages.

The RMBI will spend £10.2m redeveloping James Terry Court and when the project is completed the new home will provide up to 64 residents with accommodation of the highest standards including private, en-suite facilities for all.

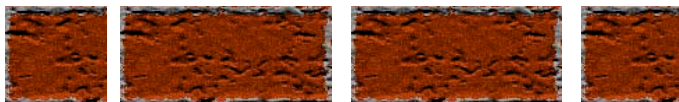
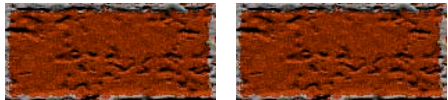
BUY-A-BRICK
